This histological diagnosis was not supported by the results of the bacteriologic culture of tissue, which established that the organism cultured was *S*.

hartford, which belongs to the salmonella C1 serogroup. *S. abortus equi*, on the other hand, is classified in the B serogroup. Accordingly, our published report stating that infection was caused by *S. abortus equi* is in error.
